Battery Powered Unit

If an outlet is not in close proximity, a battery powered TILT is available.

The rechargeable battery pack mounts to the wall (5" x 16" wall space required) within 3' of the TILT, providing power for approx. 20 cycles with a full charge.

Battery features a 1-year warranty.
